

Guidelines for Poster Presenters

Poster Size: Each poster session author will be provided with one side of a free-standing poster board. Recommended maximum poster size is 90 cm wide x 120 cm high (= 35,4 x 47,2 inches). Posters can be fixed to the board with push pins. Pins can be picked up at the registration office.

Design Suggestions: Please make sure that your poster can easily be read from a distance. Using simple fonts like Arial or Times and large font sizes (18 point or larger for body texts; larger fonts for title and headings) will ensure this. Using visual aids like graphs, charts and/or tables rather than text will make your poster more effective. Color might be a helpful tool in presenting your ideas. Yet, keep in mind that too many diverse fonts or colors might eventually distract from the poster's content. It is advisable to make usage of bullet points for the presentation of your major results. Furthermore, consider that the ICCA10 Abstract Book will include the abstracts of posters, so you are free to decide whether you want to incorporate the text of your abstract into your poster.

Setting Up Your Poster: You will be able to set-up your poster starting Sunday, July 4, 16:00. Make sure to allow yourself enough time for the set-up. The poster exhibition is situated on the second floor of the university's east wing. Since we are unable to provide you with an outlet or small table for the area in which you will display your poster, we recommend that you do not plan to use your laptop during your presentation.

Poster Removal: We kindly ask you to remove your poster no later than 16:30 on Thursday, July 8. Posters which are not removed by this time will be disposed of.

Poster Session: There is one specific viewing session on Wednesday, July 7, from 11:00–13:00. Presenters are then expected to be available for presentation and discussion of their posters. You might want to provide interested researchers with handouts summarizing the key points of your poster and including your contact information.

Poster Award: The conference guests will vote for the three best posters at ICCA10 which will be awarded poster prizes sponsored by De Gruyter. The award ceremony will take place before the final keynote lecture beginning on Thursday, July 8, at 16:30.
